CRIMINAL OFFENCE SUMMARIES

This is published every year through Waterloo Regional Police Service's Annual Report and Statistics Canada. It is based on Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) and measures the incidence of crime and its characteristics in Waterloo Region.

Waterloo Regional Police Service – Criminal Offence Summary – Most Serious Violation

Notes:

- Extracted from WRP's Police Research Management System on 8/2/2022 11:48:26 AM. Data from the comparison previous time frame is in italic.
- Statistics Canada's Uniform Crime Reporting Service was designed to measure the incidence of crime in Canadian society and its characteristics. UCR data is for most serious violations.
- The most serious violation methodology (MSV) is used, which is the same as Statistics Canada's methodology. The MSV counts only the first of up to four offences per incident that occurred in the specific time range, for violations against the person, violation counts are based upon the number of victims.
- "NC" represents "Not Calculable".

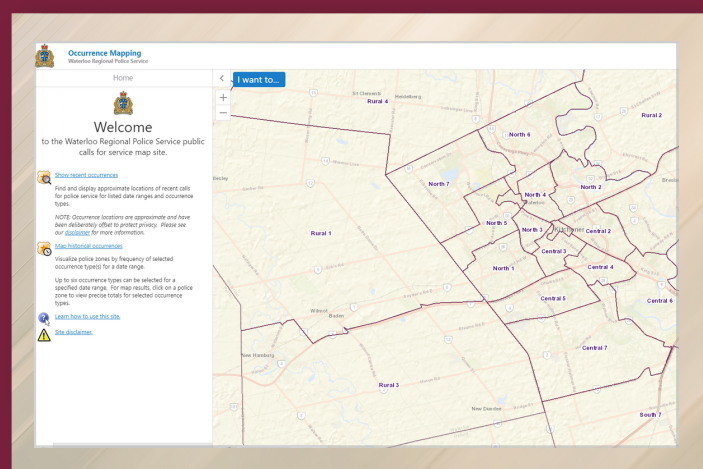


ACCESS TO INFORMATION
